SCHOOLS

Schools are under constant pressure to promote LGBT ideology.

Please pray:

Giving thanks that draft Government guidance steers English schools away from affirming a child's belief they are the opposite sex;

That children would hear the Gospel in school and be protected from ungodly teaching.

That a similar imminent proposal from Alicia Kearns MP would be rejected;

That the Westminster and Scottish governments would drop their own plans for ‘conversion therapy’ legislation;

Giving thanks for the freedom to fulfil the Gospel’s demand to call sinners to repentance.

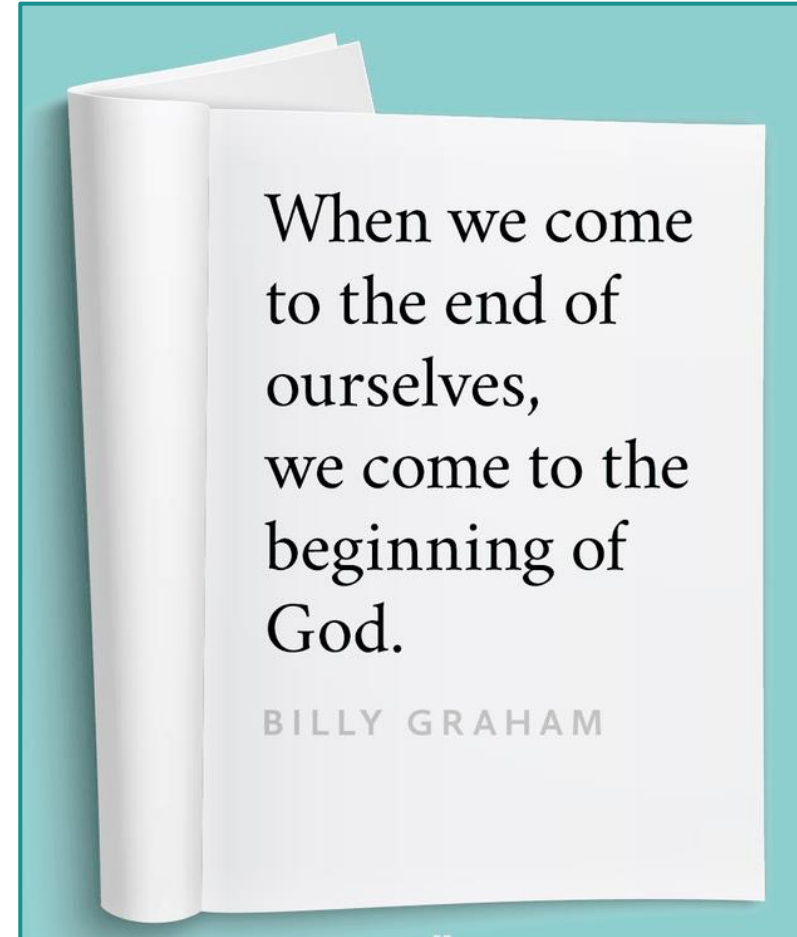
Please pray:
